## **Course Aims, Objectives**

- 35 hours of verifiable CPD related to implant dentistry for UK dentists
- Delegates will be registered with the Future University and granted a temporary licence to provide treatment for patients at the University, in Cairo.
- Live-patient hands-on experience of surgical placement of dental implants.
- Delegates will plan and place 10 implants each under close clinical supervision by UK based implant-dentistry mentors.
- Each Day consists of: presentations, PBL and treatment planning seminars and supervised surgical placement of dental implants.
- Delegates receive continuous feedback and gain insight into their individual learning and development needs

## **Course Learning Outcomes**

Course participants will be provided with teaching and clinical experience with the aim of giving them a good understanding and a working knowledge of how to:

- Clinically assess a patient's suitability for implant therapy and undertake a risk-benefit analysis, including the identification of any dental or medical conditions the patient has that could make them unsuitable for implant treatment or could complicate surgery.
- Be able to determine if the complexity of the case falls within his/her clinical experience and know when to make an appropriate referral.
- Communicate well with the patient, to ensure s/he: - is fully informed about other treatment options, and the relative indications and contra-indications; - is fully informed of the risks of the recommended treatment plan and the advantages and disadvantages of using implant anchorage in restoring the appearance and function of their dentition; - gives consent at every stage of the treatment.
- Undertake appropriate imaging (in line with Ionising Radiation Medical Exposure Regulations - IRMER).
- Use aseptic surgical techniques.
- Raise mucoperiosteal flaps and suture.
- Use appropriate pharmaceutical agents

- **Undertake straightforward implant-supported restorative procedures.**
- **Diagnose and deal with complications occurring during or after treatment**
- **Monitor and maintain implants and restorations over time.**
- **Carry out adequate record keeping, documenting and auditing of all clinical activity.**
