#### Case submissions

## Mentoring & Coaching

If the delegates want the tutors to visit their practices or if they want to perform more MOS procedures under clinical supervision, charges will apply.

## Surgical courses abroad

Tutors arrange clinical courses abroad under their supervision, these courses provide opportunity to perform surgery under the supervision if delegates cannot arrange patients at their surgeries.
