



Modular Minor Oral Surgery Course

This modular MOS course is designed specifically for practitioners looking to improve their oral surgery skills. This is an extensive hands on 4 day course, where procedures will be carried out using sheep heads to train participants to be able to perform advanced treatments like surgical extractions, wisdom teeth removal, ridge preservation for implant placements, managing complications during surgical procedures, and also the forgotten art of apicectomy.

The course will be followed up with mentoring provided by our very experienced mentors, where delegates can either attend their mentor's practice or the mentor can visit their own practice to assist and oversee cases in a familiar environment and allow the supporting team of nurses experience with these advanced procedures.

Day 1 Interactive session. 6th July 2026

Our tutor will conduct an interactive session discussing various cases and situations, medical problems, patients on anticoagulants and bisphosphonates, and how to manage other potential complications.

Day 2. Hands On. 7th July 2026

Hands on training covering incision, flap design, and suturing. Practical exercises will take place to achieve haemostasis, extraction of teeth and elevation of roots

Aims & objectives:

- Delegates will be able to understand different type of flaps.
- Have a better understanding of incisions.
- Have a grasp on different type of sutures and their indications.
- Have a better knowledge of Extractions procedure.

Day 3. Hands On Extractions. 13th July 2026

Hands on exercises of surgical extractions, wisdom teeth removal, management of impacted teeth, apicectomy

Aims & objectives:

- Better understanding of impacted teeth management in primary care.
- Better knowledge of removal of wisdom teeth at primary care level.
- Better understanding of indications and procedure of apicectomy.

Day 4. Hands On Soft Tissue. 14th July 2026

Hands on exercises of soft tissue management, biopsies, crown lengthening, as well as management of flaps and connective tissue grafts.

Aims & objectives:

- Gain a better understanding of soft tissue handling and the benefits of different techniques. Better knowledge of management of flaps, crown lengthening, and soft tissue procedures and their indications
